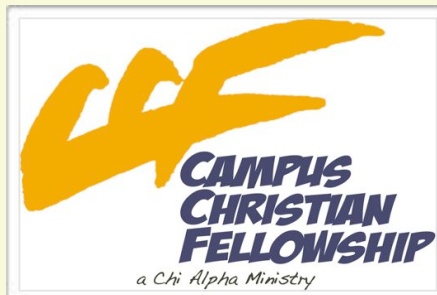

## Reach out to 4th and 5th graders!

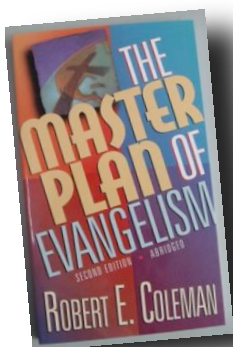
