We're excited that you are considering making application to the BXA/CCF Campus Minister in Training Program (CMIT)! Training Interns has proven to be one of our great joys as a ministry team. We are committed to mentoring you both at a personal and pastoral level, as well as helping you develop a Christian mind through Master's level studies, and deepening your skillset in the context of university missions. We are prayerfully committed to co-discerning with you participation in our internship program as a possible next step in pursuing God's will for your life.

As you consider applying for our internship here are a few things be aware of (please also see the BXA application addendum for more policies and specifics):

Discernment: We recognize that filling out this application and considering giving a year in ministry with Bellingham Chi Alpha is a big step. We expect the application and interview process with the staff to be a significant part of the discernment process, but we also recognize that it could be beneficial to meet with one of the staff before filling out the application to aid in the discernment process. If that would be helpful before filling out the application, please reach out to one of the staff as soon as possible. We are here to help!

IMPORTANT DEADLINES: Applications are due online by Tuesday, January 16, 2024. Interviews are scheduled for Wednesday or Thursday, January 24th or 25th and take about one hour. We will be making arrangements to schedule an interview time upon receiving your completed application. Notification of your acceptance status will be no later than Thursday, February 1st.

IMPORTANT DATES: Internship Orientation (training for spring/summer support-raising and studies) is scheduled for **Saturday, March 2, 2024**, 9am-noon. There will also be a more extensive support-raising training the first weekend in **April** in Ellensburg, WA.
